

Heavenly Hectares

Native Fire Retardant Species

These are species that either don't burn or burn very slowly provided that they are well managed and not 'choked' in dead weeds or fallen branches!

Trees:

Corymbia maculata – Spotted Gum
Eucalyptus spathulata – Swamp Mallet
Melaleuca lanceolata – Rottnest Island Tea Tree
Callitris preissii – Rottnest Island Pine
Pittosporum phylliariodes – Native Apricot
Casuarina cunninghamiana – River Sheoak
Casuarina obesa – Swamp Sheoak
Grevillea robusta – Silky Oak

Tall Shrubs:

Acacia saligna – Golden Wreath Wattle
Acacia Cyclops – Coastal Wattle
Hakea sauvoelens - Hakea

Small Shrubs:

Eremophila glabra – Tar Bush
Olearia species – Coastal daisies
Atriplex species – Salt Bushes
Dianella species – Dianellas
Anigozanthos species – Kangaroo paws

Creepers/ground covers:

Carbobrotus species – Native Pig Face
Kennedia prostrate – Running Postman
Kennedia coccinea – Coral Pea Vine
Hardenbergia comptoniana – Native Wisteria

Dichondria repens – Dichondria
Myoprum parvifolium – Booboolia
